Purpose & Methodology

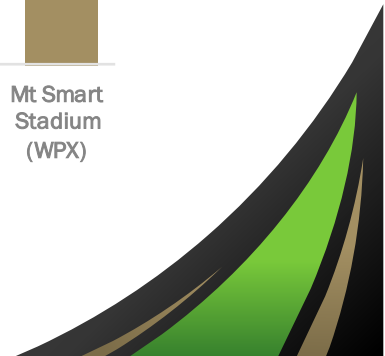
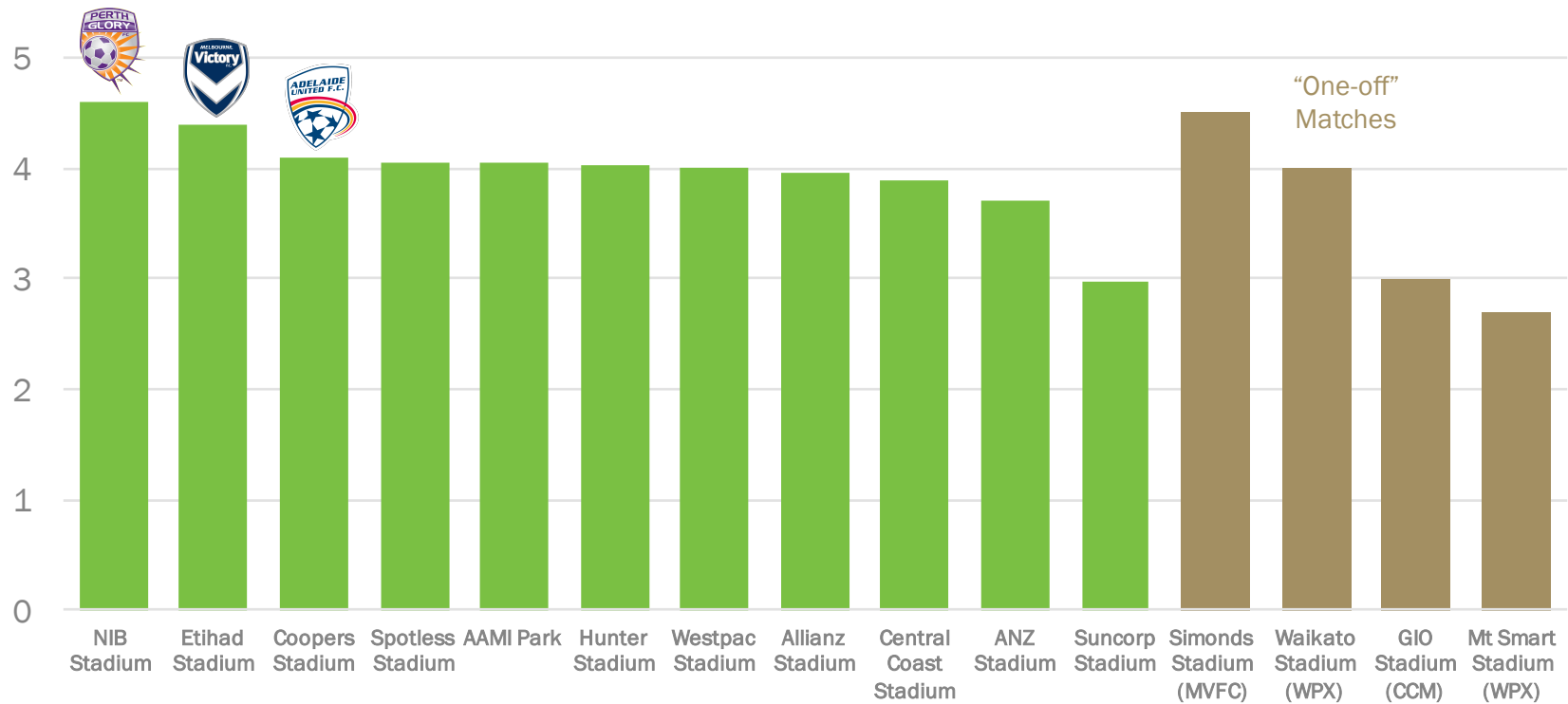
In 2009 the PFA introduced the PFA A-League Stadium Ratings System. Designed to measure the quality of football pitches across the A-League, it measures four key criteria of the playing surface: overall quality, hardness, pace and smoothness. Additionally, it recognises fans as a key pillar for the growth of the A-League and measures the weather conditions in which the match took place.

The PFA A-League Stadium Ratings are voted on by selected players at the end of each match, who rate each criteria from one to five, with five being the highest.



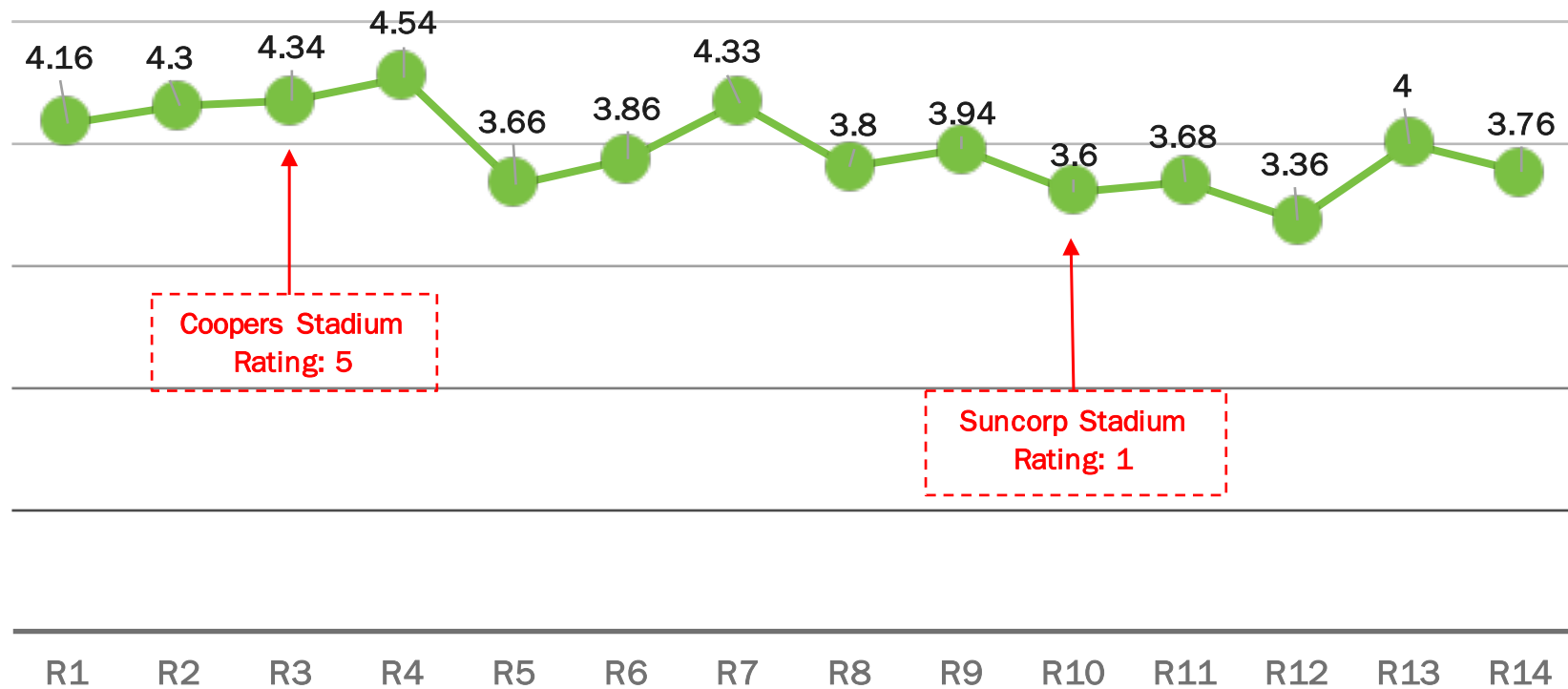

Overall average during 2016/17 as @ Round 14



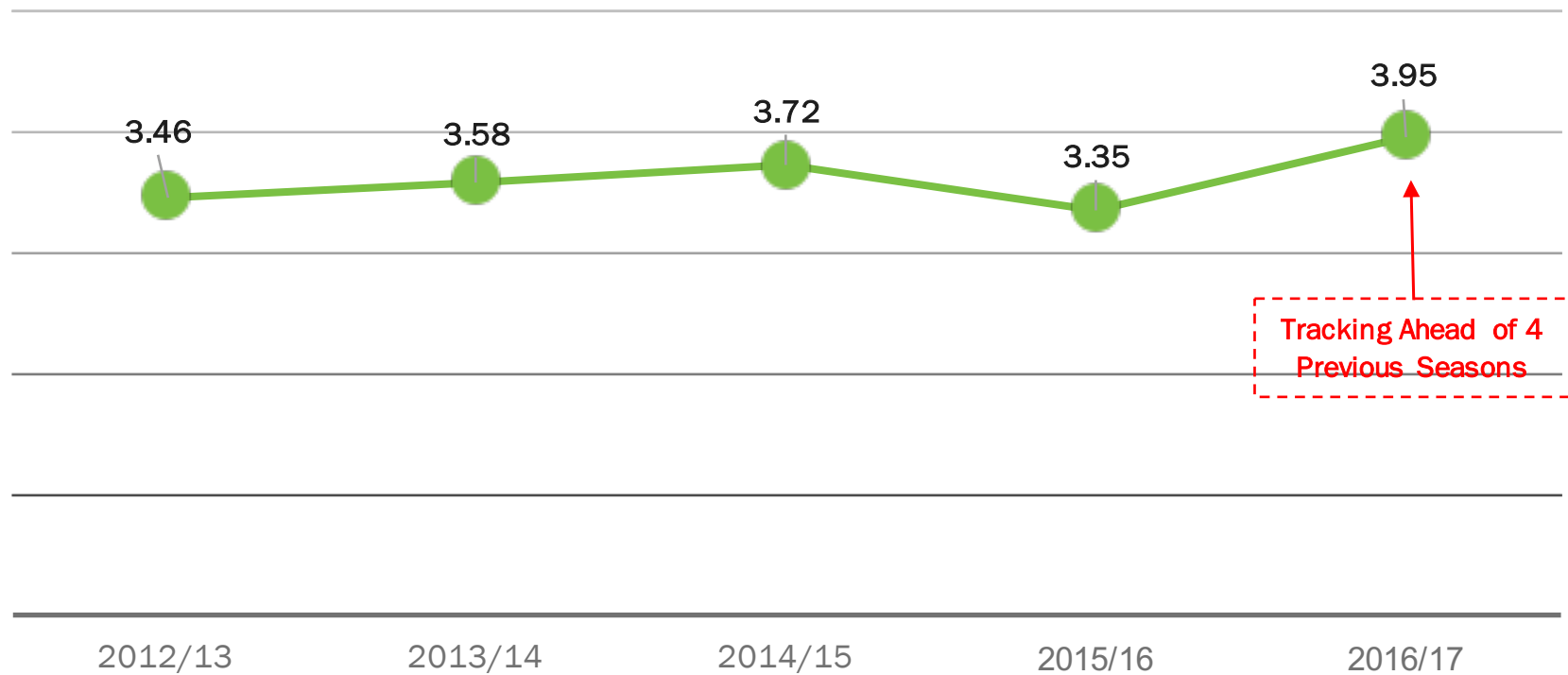
PITCH RATINGS

Weekly Average across 2016/17 as @ Round 14



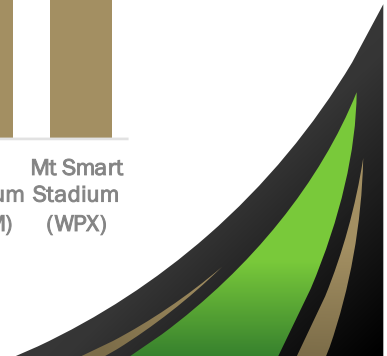
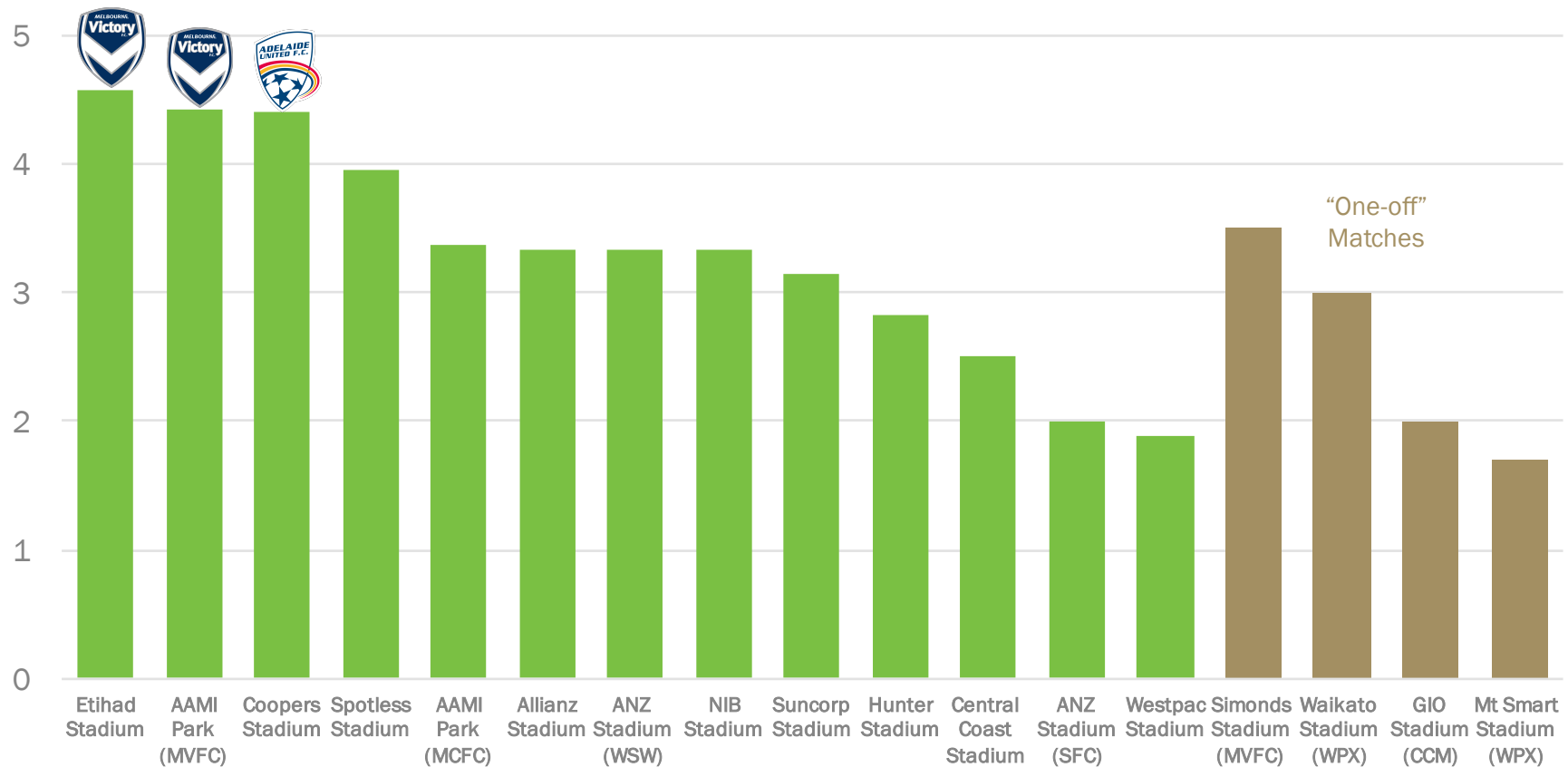

Overall average Season by Season Comparison



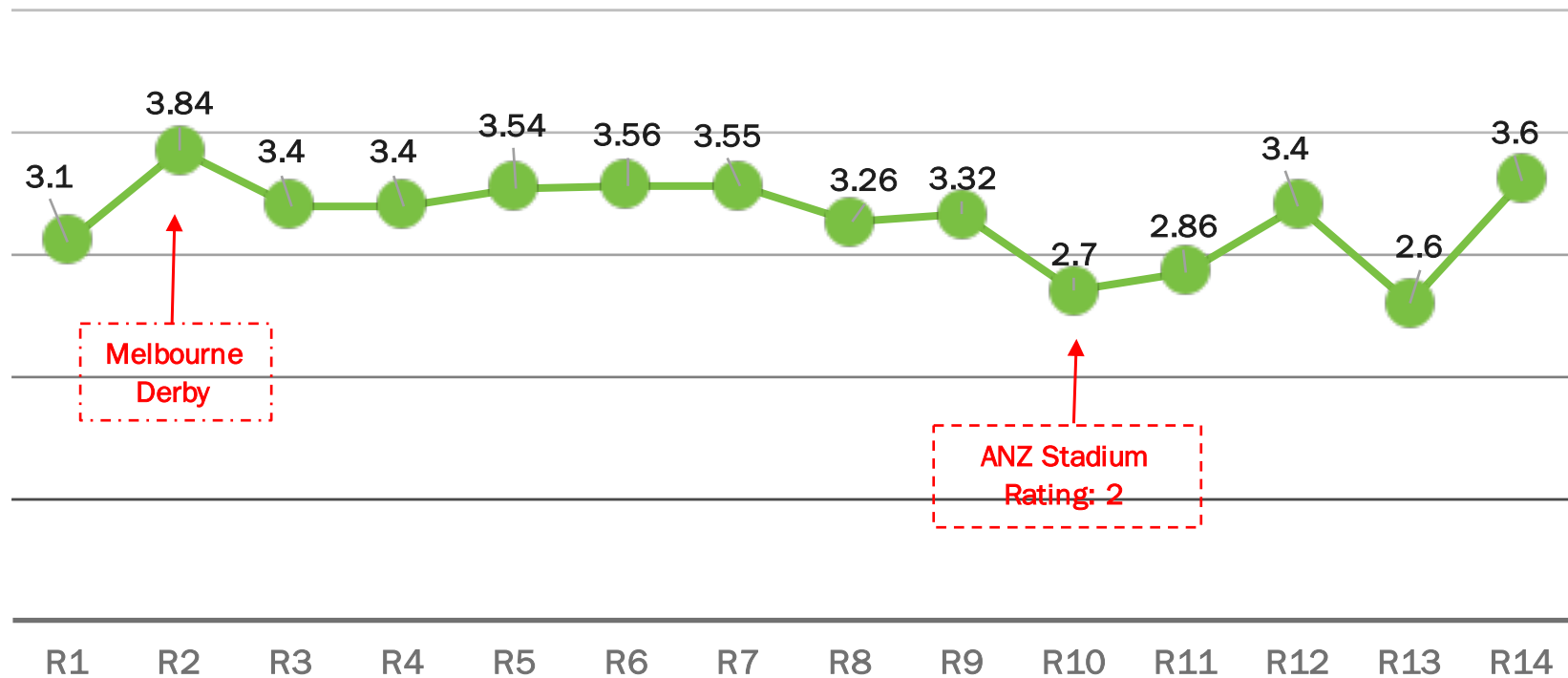

Overall average for 2016/17 as @ Round 14



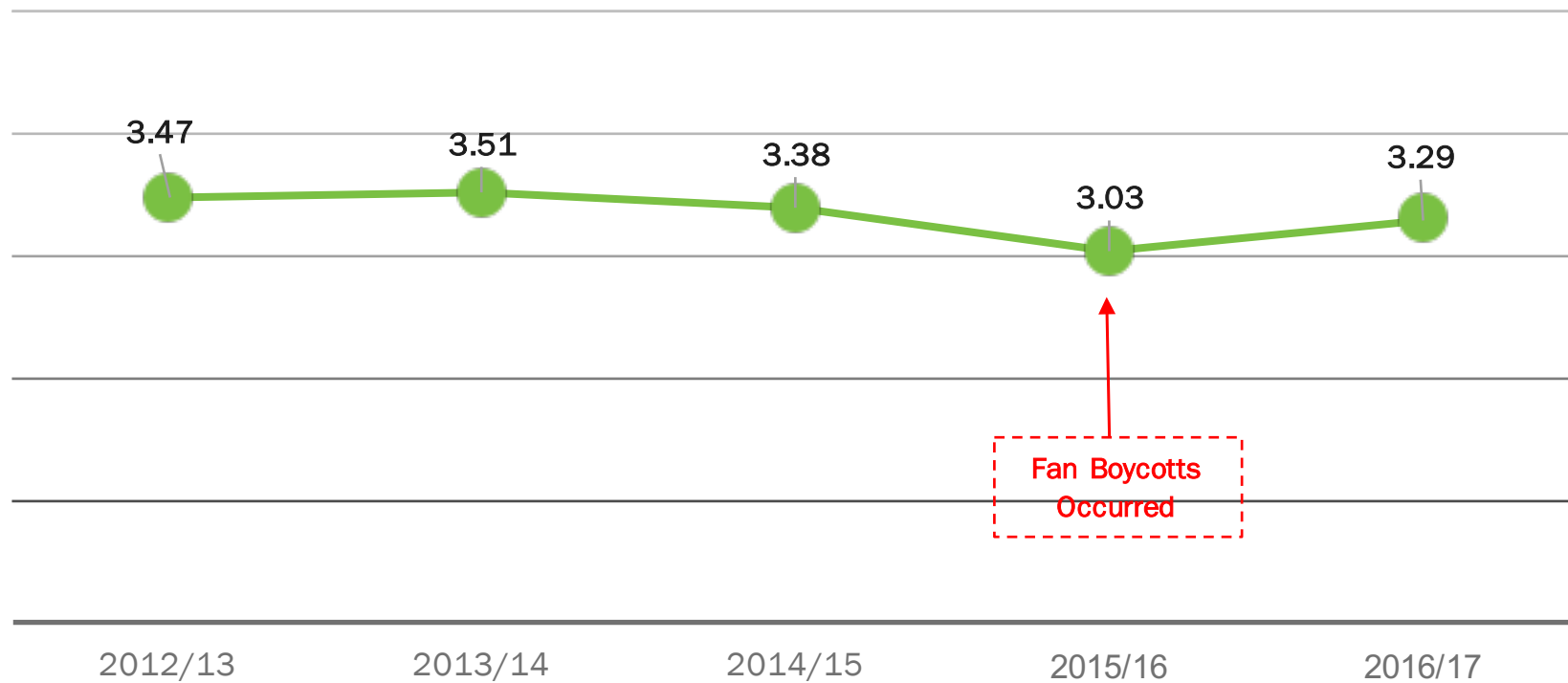
